Annual Survey of Fraternal Activities

On January 16, 2012, the **2011 Annual Survey of Fraternal Activities** was submitted to the Supreme, State and District deputies. This report consists of a list of all activities our Council was involved in, the number of hours volunteered throughout the year, total council activity expenses, and total charitable (church, community/needy, youth) disbursements.

Here is a brief summary of those disbursements: Church, \$3,472; community/needy, \$13,719; youth, \$5,808; for a total of **\$22,999**. In addition, we also spent a total of \$3,535 on council activities. The number of hours dedicated to volunteer charitable and fraternal services were as follows: Church, 4,702 hours; community, 2,053 hours; and an estimated 1,906 hours of other volunteer services, for a total of **8,661 hours**.

You are an example of what the Knights are all about; a living proof that, by volunteering, we can make a difference both in the parish and the larger community. Our thanks also goes out to Bros.
